- **Advocacy and Awareness:** To create a platform where students can voice the importance of gender-inclusive legislation for the overall development of the nation.

Outcomes :

Upon completion of the program, the participants were able to:

- **Critically Evaluate Policy:** Participants engaged in discussions regarding the timeline of implementation and the role of delimitation.
- **Enhanced Civic Engagement:** A measurable increase in interest among students from diverse streams (Zoology, CS, Economics, and Commerce) to participate in student union activities or civic advocacy.
- **Empowerment:** A strengthened sense of agency among the 60 participants regarding their rights to political representation.

Brief Report of the Program

The **Women Empowerment Cell** organized a specialized awareness session titled "**Nari Shakti Vandan Adhiniyam**" on **April 13, 2026**. The event focused on the landmark Women's Reservation Bill of 2023, which seeks to reserve one-third of seats in the Lok Sabha and State Legislative Assemblies for women.

The program commenced with an introductory note by the Event Coordinator, **Shaik Aaisha**, who highlighted the necessity of gender parity in the corridors of power. The session saw active participation from **60 students** across various disciplines, including BSc Zoology, BSc Computer Science, BA Economics, and B.Com CA, showcasing a multidisciplinary interest in the topic.

The Resource Person, **Dr. K. Vasudha (Principal)**, delivered an insightful keynote address. She traced the long journey of the bill—from its inception decades ago to its recent passage—and explained its potential to reshape the Indian political landscape. Dr. Vasudha emphasised that political empowerment is the cornerstone of social and economic independence for women. A PowerPoint presentation was given by **Sri.Y.Maninder Rao**, Lecturer in Political Science on women reservation Bill 2023.

The event concluded with an interactive Q&A session where students discussed the hurdles to implementation and the importance of "Reservation within Reservation." The program ended on a high note with a collective pledge by the students to stay informed and active in the nation's democratic processes.

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
