



In the G.O, first read above, the embargo placed against the naming of the Educational Institutions after donors, was removed and it was ordered that each case should be examined on merit by government several generous and and philanthropic persons are donating liberal amounts for the construction of school buildings on conditions that the schools are to be named after them or their nominee. In view of the several such cases received the matter and in supersession of all the provision orders on the subject direct that the following principles should be followed while considering the proposals for naming the schools and college after the donors.

1. A school or college may be named after the donors when the donation exceeds 50% of the estimated cost of the building of the institution.
2. If the donation converts the cost of a building or a block in a school or ~~exit~~ college the building may be named after the donor and
3. When the entire land for play ground is donated by an individual the play ground may be named after the donor.

In the G.O. First read above orders were issued relating to the principles that should be followed while considering the proposals for naming the schools and Colleges after the donors as follows:-

1. School or College may be named after the donor when the donation exceeds 50% of the estimated cost of the building of the institution.
 2. If the donation covers the cost of the building or a block in a school or college, the building may be named after the donor; and
 3. When the entire land for the play ground is donated by any individual, the play ground may be named after the donor.
2. Government have reviewed the above principles and decided to issue the following amendment:

For item 1 of para 1 of the G.O. first read above shall be read as

" School or College may be named after the donor, when the donation at 25% of the estimated cost of the building of the institution"
