

3.4.2 Awards and recognitions received for extension activities from government/government recognized bodies

All UG programs, which give students experiential learning opportunities through community engagement, have the extension activities as a fundamental component. Through their interactions with the people, students get the chance to learn about the significance of social service, human values, traditions, and interpersonal relationships - all of which contribute to the holistic development of the student.

Participating in community service initiatives in neighboring villages is the primary goal. This morning, a survey was conducted in a few of the villages to learn more about their socioeconomic status and the issues they have faced as a community, including access to drinking water and water infrastructure. After realizing their issues, the locals conducted evidence-based programs to synthesize all of the problems they were facing, including a balanced diet that is both simple and green, health and housing issues, excessive plastic disposal, water pollution from using home and electronic appliances, maternal and child health, energy conception, inviting mental hygiene, and communicable diseases.
