## SUMMARY REPORT OF THE CERTIFICATE COURSE

The Certificate Course in Gandhian Studies, conducted by the Department of History under the Faculty of Arts, was held from August 1, 2018, to September 14, 2018. This 30-day intensive program aimed to provide participants with a comprehensive understanding of Mahatma Gandhi's life, philosophy, and socio-political ideologies. The course was designed to develop analytical skills for critically evaluating contemporary societal challenges and encourage the application of Gandhian ideals in real-world scenarios.
