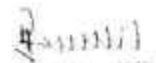

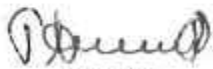



- **History:** The idea of the National Service Scheme (NSS) was propagated by Major General Jagannath Rao Bhonsle. The University Grants Commission, headed by S. Radhakrishnan, officially recommended bringing voluntary national service into academic institutions. This concept was further discussed in a meeting of the Central Advisory Board of Education (CABE) in January 1950. After examining experiences from other countries, CABE recommended that students and teachers should participate in voluntary manual work.
- **Benefits:**
 - NSS Day is a special occasion to honour and celebrate the efforts of every volunteer in working towards the well-being of everyone in their community.
 - The NSS program is designed to help volunteers understand their community to foster a deep sense of responsibility for improving society. It focuses on the personal development of each volunteer through community service.





ANNUAL DAY CELEBRATIONS

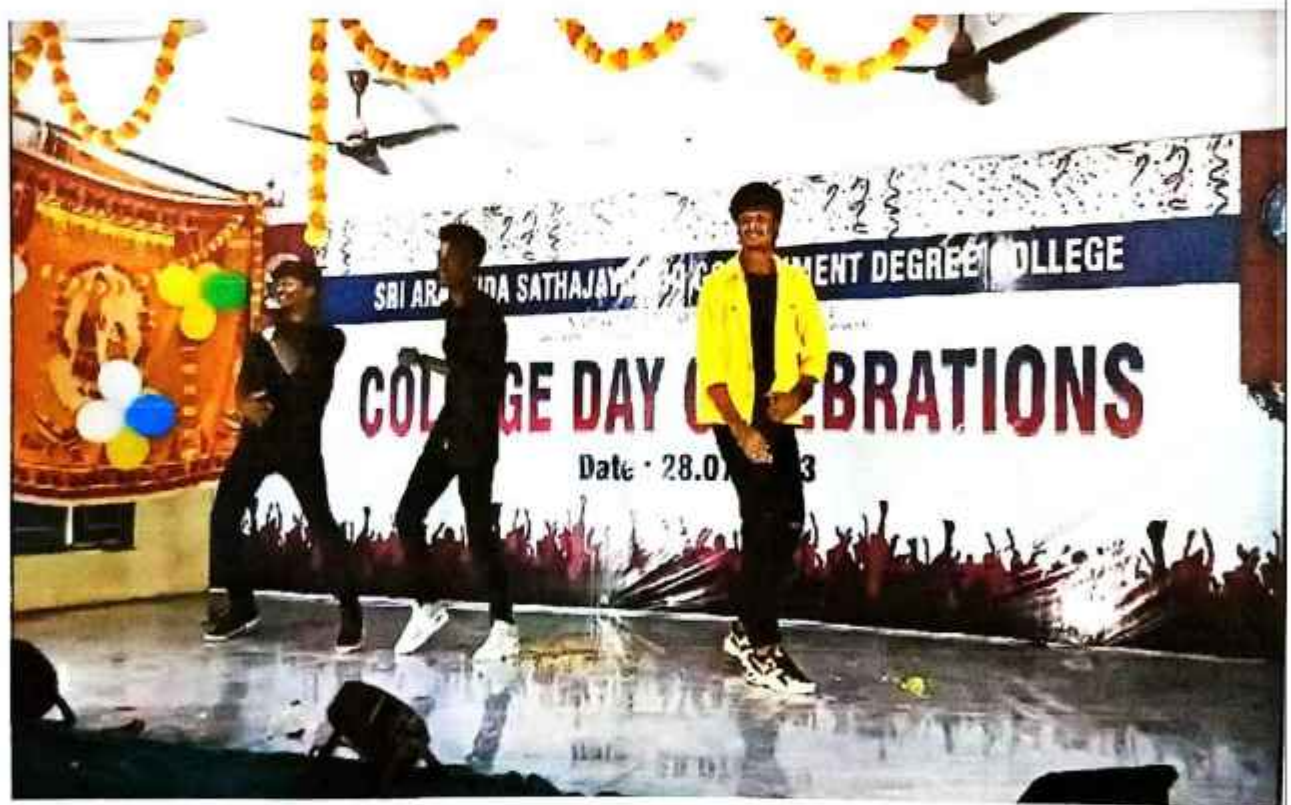
