### STUDENT FED BACK ANALYSIS REPORT 2019-2020

Based on the student satisfactory survey on the syllabus and its transaction at the institution, the analysis is done with an idea to improve for the development of the institution in process of extending better educational service to the students.

- 20 attributes were given to the students for making their opinions on teaching and learning to fill up the feedback form.
- 140 samples were collected for the academic year **2019-2020** from all courses offered.
- 5 Rating were provided i.e. **excellent, very good, good, average & Poor.**
- In the analysis it is found that **2.14%** students opted **POOR**, with regard to column no **11** i.e **Encouraging and guiding students in reading library books using internet.**
- **3.57%** students opted **POOR** with regards to question no **10** i.e. **Aptitude shown in arranging field visits, invited lectures etc., in the subject.**
- Regarding **16<sup>th</sup>** and **11<sup>th</sup>** questions **10%** and **7%** respondents opted average i.e **Enthusiasm shown to encourage and guide students in extracurricular, activities like cultural, community service, nation building etc, and Encouraging and guiding students in reading library books using internet.**
- But in last column i.e. "Overall opinion on the lecturer respondents" opted-**19.9%** good **25%** very good and **48.41%** excellent. Hence, overall performance of the lecturers in extending their services is-**excellent.**



After a careful analysis of the student's feedback analysis the following recommendations/resolutions made under the chairmanship of the principal to enhance the quality of teaching learning process

- Feedback analysis was presented in staff council, discussed and unanimously resolved by the staff council/Communicated to university through BoS members/subject wise departmental conference at various university academic meetings regarding the student feedback on syllabus transaction.
- Resolved to pay more attention towards **poor and average** performance areas and suggestions were conveyed to the teachers concerned for betterment
- The report was sent to the higher authorities through principal.

# Student Feed back Analysis & Flow chart -2019-20






