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GREEN CAMPUS INITIATIVES

- SAS Government Degree College, Narayanapuram initiates eco friendly and environmentally sustainable activities. It aims at minimum waste, protection of bio-diversity. Conservation of Energy and protection of natural resources. Through the conscientious efforts of NSS and Eco club the college is striving towards the clean and green campus.
- The college Campus sprawls in an area of 5.77 acres of land. Ever since its inception, the college is striving for clean and green campus thus protecting the sylvan atmosphere in spite of its being situated beside the National Highway.
- Use of plastic is banned in college campus. Students are made aware of the situation by conducting “Plastic Free Drives” in the middle of every semester.
- Automobiles are allowed up to the parking area only. Barricades were arranged at suitable places to restrict the movement of vehicles in the campus.
- The College has good landscaping. Different types of saplings are planted every year in special programs like “Haritha Andhra Pradesh ” during every monsoon season. It actively participates in Chettu - Neeru (Plant & Water) program initiated by the State government
- The age old Trees in the campus provide cool shade to the Administrative block and Science Block .
- Flower garden and botanical garden are being maintained by the department of Botany and Eco-Club
- The College is using solar energy and darkness sensor based rechargeable LED lighting systems to illuminate outdoor areas during late hours.
- All the lighting sources used in the college are Energy Efficient LED lights.
- The Solid Waste generated in the campus is disposed off in a systematic manner. Dust bins are placed at all important places in the campus to collect the waste. Two compost pits were established in the campus. The bio-degradable waste and leaves of trees are dumped in to the pits for decomposition.

- The manures produced from this process are used for plants in the college garden.. The non-degradable waste are disposed off with the help of Gram Panchayat.
- Liquid waste generated in the campus is disposed off in a systematic way through a proper drainage system.
- Environmental Education is made a compulsory life skill course for all the students in the semester II of first year .
- Rain water harvesting pits are constructed at suitable places to recharge the groundwater levels.
- The waste water from purifier is channelized in to the college garden.
- Water resources and distribution system are periodically checked and maintained by the office to minimize wastage.
- No vehicle day is observed on every second and fourth Saturday of month.
- Environmental awareness and sensitization programmes are conducted by NSS, Eco club, Departments of Botany and Chemistry on regular basis
- The “Save Soil Day” is observed every year.
- NSS unit, Eco-club and all the departments initiated awareness programmes on Earth Day, Ozone Day, World Environment Day etc.,
- A certificate course in Soil Analysis is offered by Department of Chemistry and Certificate course in Sustainable Home Gardening is offered by the Department of Botany.
- The chirping of the birds feasts the ears of the morning walkers and the college staff and students as well.
- One can experience the coolness in the premises especially during summer season due to reduction in temperature by green cover.
- The certificate with “ISO: 1400:2015” for implementation of Green cover and Environment promotion activities.
- The campus is clean and green, records at least two degrees of less temperature compared with the rest of Narayanapuram village.
